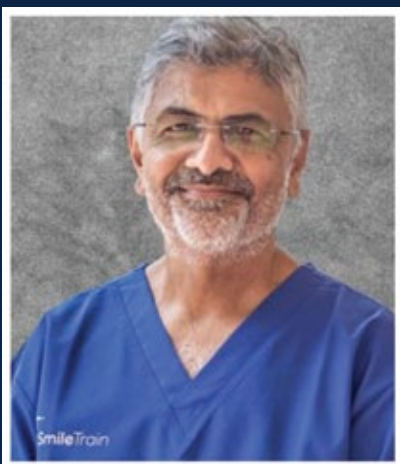




INDOCLEFTCON 2022

Introduction to cleft care and managing challenges in cleft orthodontics

Moderator – Dr. Puneet Batra Dr. Ranjith Ramakrishnan



A practical, step wise guide to demystify cleft orthodontics. It will introduce the various protocols at different stages in the patient's life. Starting from childhood it will enable the orthodontist to understand what needs to be done at different stages and at what time points different specialities have to be included. Thus the necessity for a team approach will be instigated. Furthermore, the surgeon's perspective of the orthodontic requirements for surgery and how to manage and avoid slip-ups and missteps will be included. There will be active discussions to encourage interactive sessions. The course will be ideal for trainees, beginners and practitioners.

Cleft Surgical video workshop

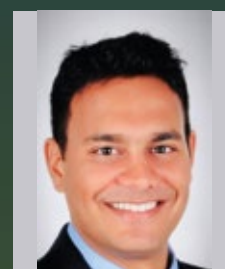

A panel of judges in individual category will scrutinize the manuscripts and 6 from each category will be selected for podium presentation during the conference. These will be announced by 30th

April. 2022.

Papers not chosen for podium presentation will automatically revert to the 'Free Paper' category.

It is mandatory for the Oral / Poster presenters to be registered for the conference.

About Kochi



Kochi called the "Queen of the Arabian Sea" is a major port city on the Malabar Coast of India bordering the Laccadive Sea, which is a part of the Arabian Sea. It is the financial capital of Kerala and is one of the major tourist destinations in India. Willingdon Island, large man-made island made from sand dredged from the backwaters to deepen the Kochi Port. Named after Long Willingdon, then-the reigning Viceroy of India, it houses the Kochi Port, Southern Naval Command Headquarters of Indian Navy and many five star hotels. Peninsula of Mattencherry and Fort Kochi (Old Kochi) primarily a tourist enclave. Fort Kochi forms the upper part of the Peninsula with neatly arranged colonial buildings, narrow well-paved roads, Anglo-Dutch influenced structures and large antique shops. West Kochi, consists of famous tourist village Kumbalangi, small fishing hamlets like Edakochi, Kumbalam, Perumpadappu etc, all known for their scenic beauty. Bolgatty Island is a British established Royal Residency, which is now converted into a five star hotel along with upcoming India's largest convention center. Famous for its large golf course, horse riding tracks, marina and boatyards.

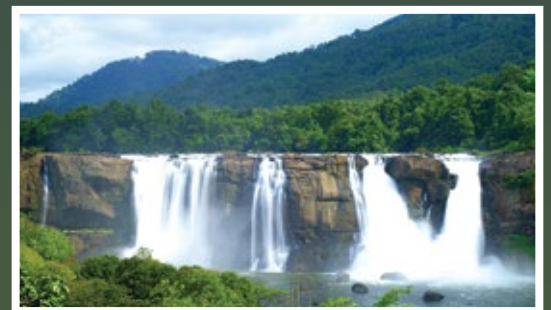
